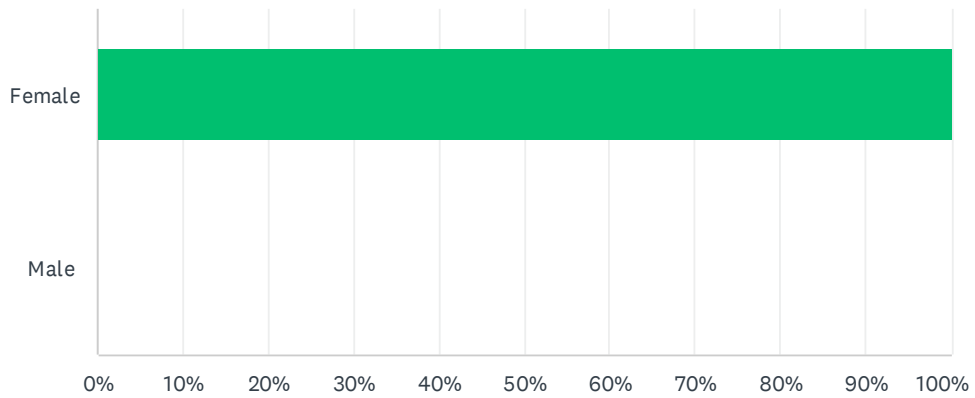

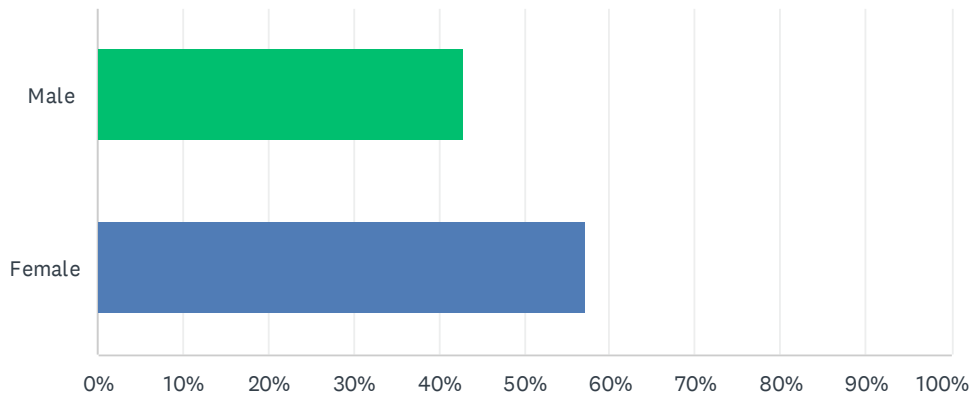

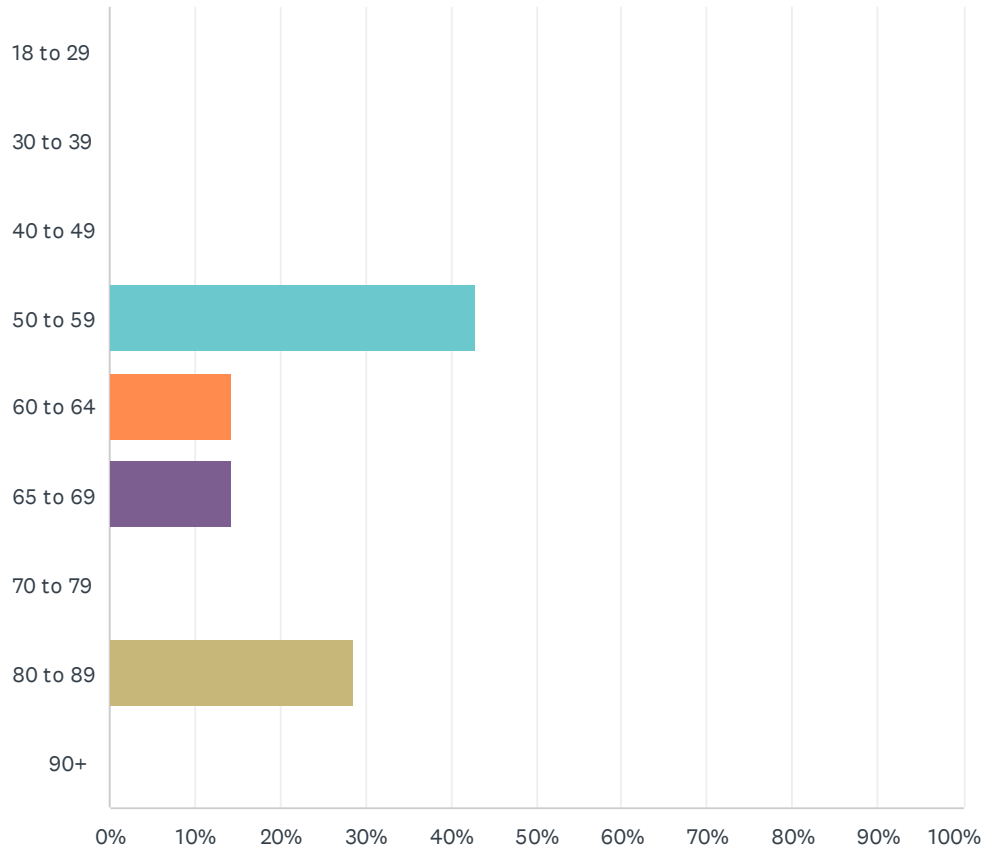

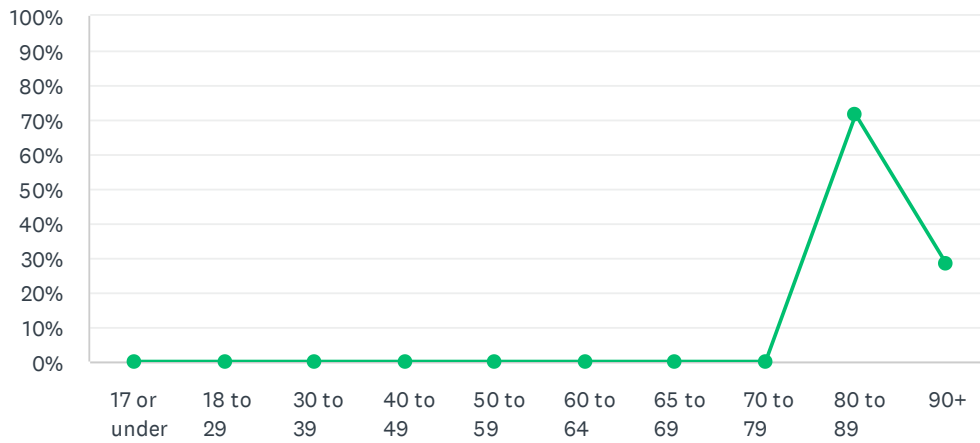

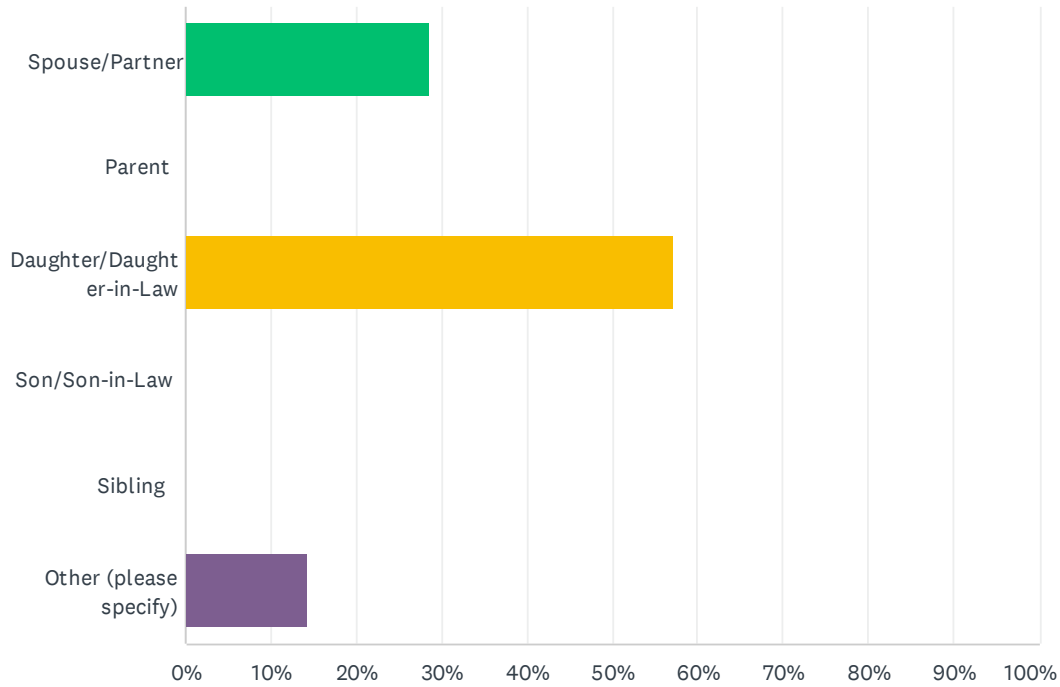

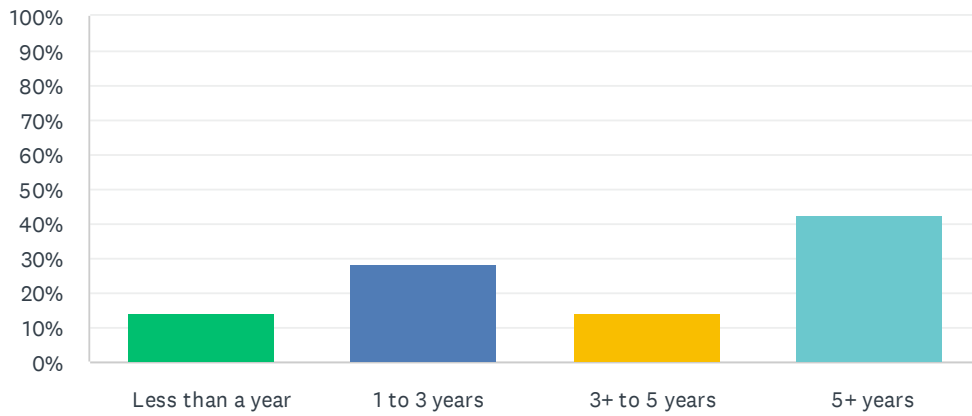

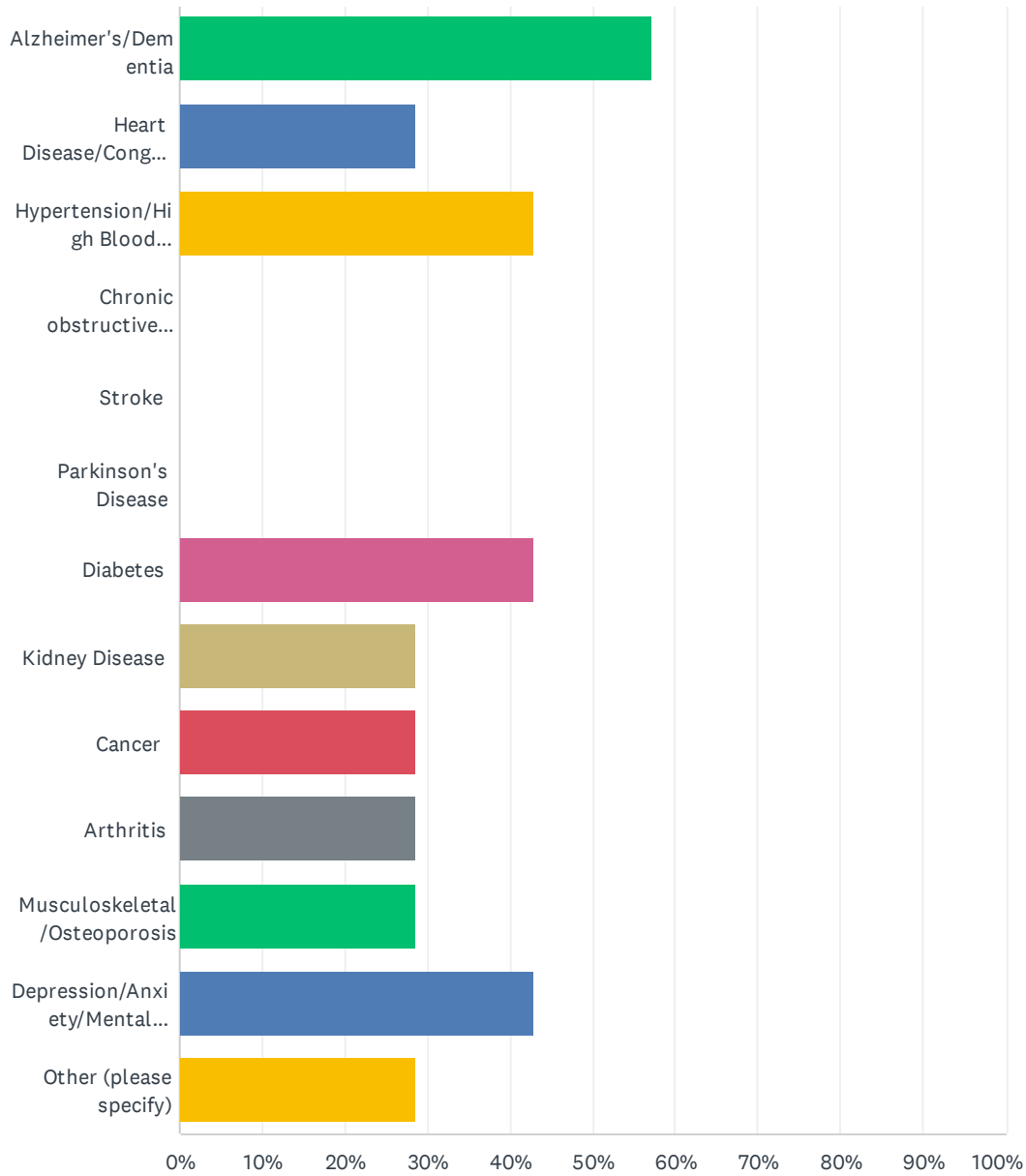

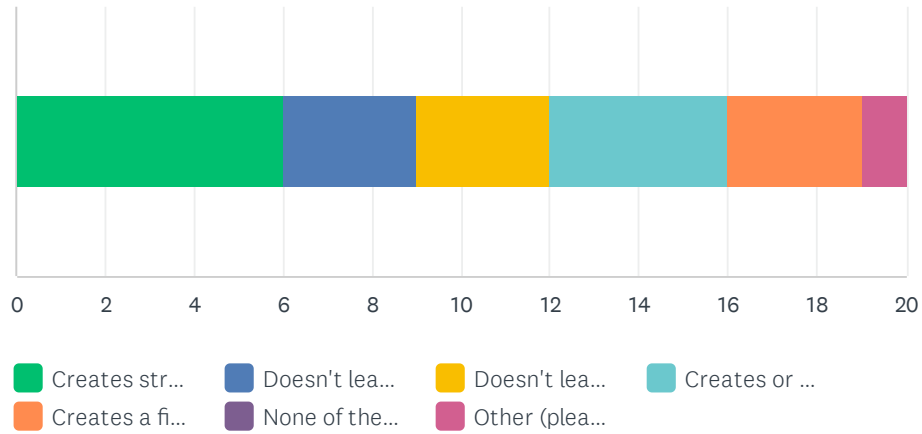

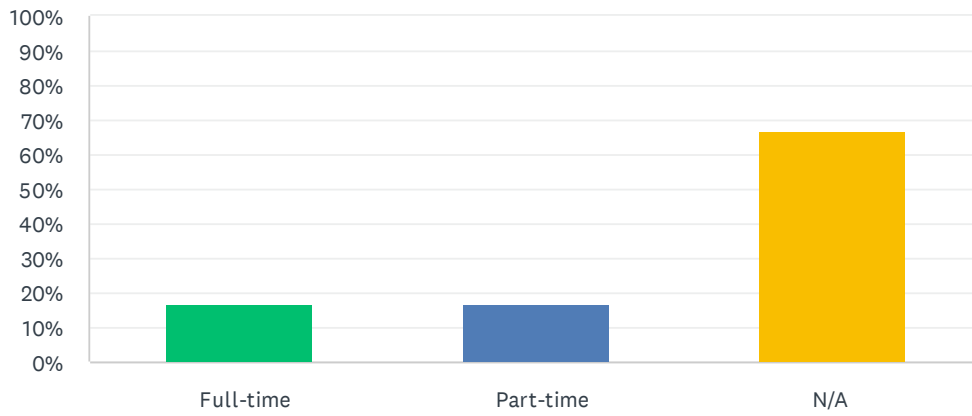

Q10 Are you employed?

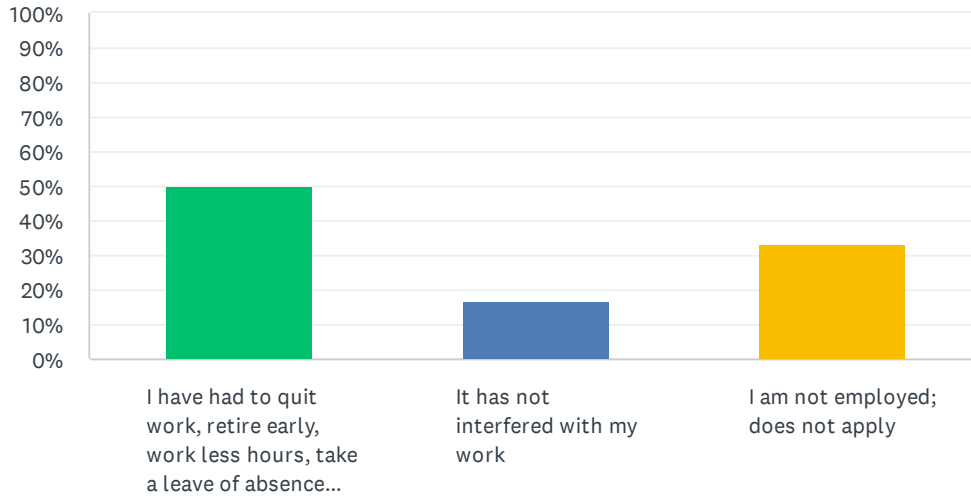

Q11 How have your caregiving responsibilities impacted your employment?

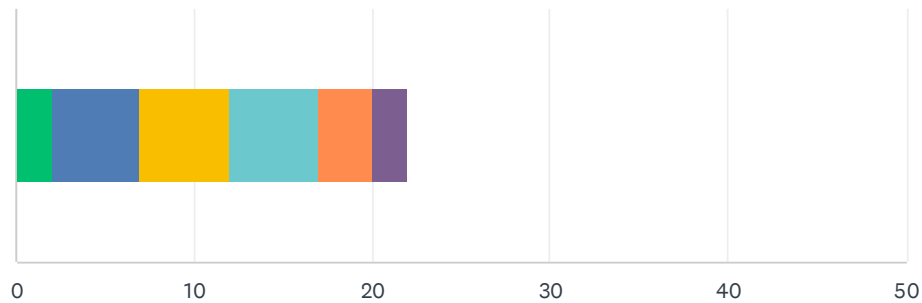

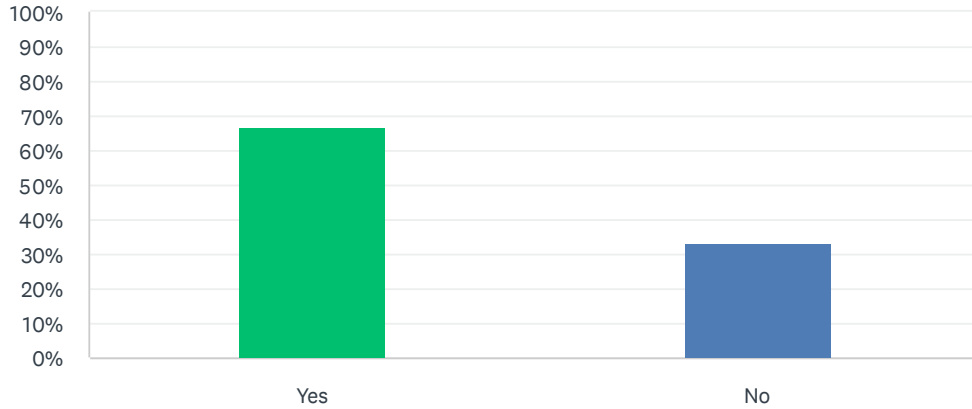

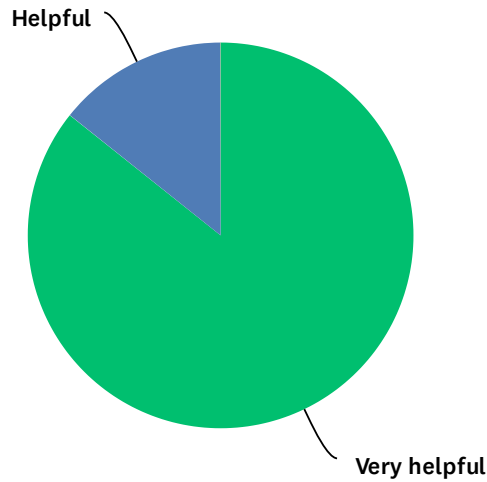
