
Q3 What is the gender of the person you care for?

Q4 What is your age?









Q8 Please check the diseases/illnesses of the person you are caring for (check all that apply) :




Q9 What are the greatest difficulties you have faced in your role as a caregiver? (check all that apply)




Q11 How have your caregiving responsibilities impacted your employment?




Q13 Have the caregiver services enabled you to provide care for a longer period of time than would have been possible without these services?


Q14 Have the caregiver services you received helped to delay the placement of the person you care for to an assisted living or skilled nursing home?


Q15 Have the services you received from the Caregiver Support Program enabled you to be more self-reliant in your role as a caregiver?









Q20 Did your case manager provide you with information that was clear, beneficial, and helpful to you as a caregiver?



Q21 Did your case manager involve you in planning services that were individualized to your specific needs?






Q23 What are your plans now that you are no longer receiving respite services that are funded through the Caregiver Support Program? (check all that apply)
