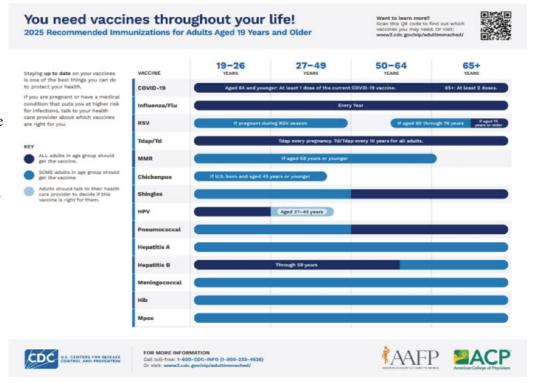
Fall Vaccinations

Immunization, also known as <u>vaccination</u>, is a process that prepares the body to fight off specific diseases by exposing it to a weakened or inactive version of the disease-causing agent. This process helps the body develop immunity without causing the full-blown illness, protecting individuals from future infections. Immunization is a cru-

cial public health strategy that has significantly reduced the incidence and severity of many infectious diseases.

It would be ideal if everybody was immunized by the end of October. But, don't worry if you don't get it by then. The flu season peaks in February and could go as long as May. Along with the flu vaccine, there are other vaccines available to keep you healthy. The following vaccines are suggested for optimal protection.

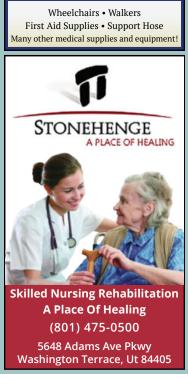

This is a great time of year to see if you are getting the most savings out of your Part D or Advantage plan. A little bit of time can mean big savings. We as your local State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) would love to help you navigate this process. The SHIP program is a free and non-biased program that is government funded. We can look over your Medicare plan, assist you in lowering your Part D medications if you qualify for the Medicaid or Extra Help (LIS) program, and help you report any errors, fraud, or abuse. Medicare Open Enrollment is a time to watch out for increased marketing violations!

Here are some things to watch out for:

Unsolicited contact: Agents should not call you without your prior consent, knock on your door, or approach you in public spaces.

Misleading language: Avoid agents who use terms like "free" or "best" without proper justification or suggest their plan is "Medicare-endorsed."

Pressure tactics: Don't feel pressured to enroll immediately or make decisions based on fearmongering.

Cross-selling: Agents should not try to sell you non-health-related products, like life insurance, during a Medicare sales appointment, unless you specifically request it.

Inaccurate claims: Be wary of agents who make guarantees about coverage, costs, or benefits that are not backed by evidence.

Gifts and prizes: Be aware that agents can only offer gifts or prizes worth less than \$15, and they must be available to the general public, not just those enrolling in their plan.

Suggesting Medicare endorsement: Agents cannot imply that Medicare endorses their plan.
